836. Public Transport in the area

The Clerk advised members of a recent report from the Public Transport Group and confirmed that the County Council were looking at the possibility of using a double decker bus for the 151 when it was being used to transport students to school.

838. Youth Council web site

It was noted that it would cost £100 to have an additional page on the Town Council's web site for news from the Youth Council. The cost would be £100 and it was proposed by Youth Cllr Ireland, seconded by Youth Cllr Bradstock and RESOLVED that the Clerk arrange for the page to be created as soon as possible with the cost being found from the Youth Council budget.

839. Youth Council projects

The Clerk advised that on the assumption that Rotary would still contribute to the music festival the sum of £257.70 could be sent to the Birmingham Children's Hospital as the Youth Council charity for the year. The Clerk will endeavour to arrange for a representative from the charity to attend the next meeting to receive the cheque. Cllr Rowley will liaise with Rotary to ascertain whether the contribution was to be paid.

840. Youth Council Charity

In view of the end of the current Youth Council being one meeting away it was agreed to remove this item from the next agenda.

841. Christmas Light switch on 2015

The Clerk explained the request from the Chamber of Trade to bring the Christmas Light switch on forward one week to enable them to run a Georgian Fair on the same day and not to clash with Worcester's Victorian Fair.

Youth Cllr Whitehead suggested that this should be undertaken for this year on a trial basis and it was proposed by Youth Cllr Ireland, seconded by Youth Cllr Whitehead and RESOLVED that the Christmas Light Switch On be held on Saturday 21st November 2015 and a meeting be arranged as soon as possible with the Chamber of Trade and Mr Steve Knight to ensure that the two events complemented each other. The Clerk will speak to Mr Knight accordingly.
